Prior Splitboard Retreat

March 2 - 4 / 2012 (3 Day Trip)

Solitude Glacier / Les Gendarmes / Journeyman Peak / Morning Glory

Cost: \$839.00 per person + HST

Prerequisites: Strong intermediate skier/boarder comfortable on blue runs and variable snow conditions. Good fitness level.

Location: Callaghan Backcountry Lodge nestled deep in the pristine setting of the Callaghan valley.
